Basic first aid training is required and specific seizure training will be provided. Max must be the only dog in the house, although cats are fine.

Pay will be \$25-29/hour depending upon experience.

- Making sure I have taken my twice daily medications
- Responding during the night when Max alerts for a seizure
- Administering medication in specific seizure situations as per provided training
- Physically assisting me after seizures
